Strand 1: Planning Proficiency-based Instruction

Leaders: South Portland and RSU 14 teachers and administrators. **Outcomes:**

- 1. Apply a three-step proficiency-based unit planning process using local standards and indicators:
 - Use cognitive and skills-based taxonomies to build learning progressions;
 - Embed formative feedback in instruction;
 - Develop summative evidence descriptions;
 - Evaluate your district's proficiency-based instruction planning framework.

What to bring:

- Three to five indicators to plan from during the two days.
- The district's unit design process or template.

Leaders: RSU 2 and Auburn curriculum leaders and instructional coaches.

Strand 2 will simulate a personalized learning classroom with frequent step-backs

to allow participants to reflect on how to use their experiences with students.

- Building classroom culture
- Making student expectations clear and transparent
- Developing student independence and autonomy
